“DEVELOPMENT OF HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE IN RURAL AREAS”

530. SHRI C.R.PATIL:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated for the development of healthcare infrastructure in rural areas of the country during the last three years, State/UT-wise; and
- (b) the details of various programs, projects, schemes being implemented by this Ministry and financial support provided to the State of Gujarat under each of these during the last three years?

- (a) and (b): The details of funds allocated for the development of healthcare infrastructure in rural areas of the country under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) during the last three years, State/UT-wise is at Annexure.

Financial Support provided to the State of Gujarat under the following Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Department of Health & Family Welfare is as under:

- (i) **National Health Mission (NHM):** It is one of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme under which the Government of India provides financial and technical support to States/UTs to strengthen their health care systems. It comprises of two sub-missions viz. National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and National Urban Health Mission (NUHM). During the last three years i.e. from F.Y. 2018-19 to F.Y. 2020-21 funds to the tune of Rs.1038.69crore, Rs.1110.80crore and Rs.1005.66crore have been released respectively to the State of Gujarat.
- (ii) **ECRP-I:** The ‘India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health System Preparedness Package-I’ (ECRP-I) of Rs.15,000 crore has been approved by the Cabinet on 22nd April 2020 with an objective to prevent, detect and respond to the threat posed by COVID-19.

Funds to the tune of Rs. 304.16 crore have been released to the State of Gujarat during the F.Y.2020-21 under this Package through Agency-NHM. It is 100% centrally funded.

- (iii) **ECRP-II:** The Cabinet has also approved the scheme, “India Covid-19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Package-II” (ECRP-II) on 08th July 2021 for an amount of Rs.23,123 crore for the F.Y. 2021-22. The scheme aims to accelerate health system preparedness for immediate responsiveness for early prevention, detection and management of COVID-19, with the focus on health infrastructure development including for Pediatric Care and with measurable outcomes. During the F.Y. 2021-22, funds to the tune of Rs.239.61 crore has been released to the State of Gujarat through Agency-NHM and is as per approved Centre-State funding under NHM.
