#### **SETTING UP OF FPIs**

#### 5353. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has a proposal to set up Food Processing Industries (FPIs) in every district of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details along with the districts in Odisha where food processing zone have already been set up;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to set up food processing zone in the remaining districts; and
- (d) the financial assistance provided by the Government to the private entrepreneurs to set up such units?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (d): The Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) does not setup any food processing industries/ units/projects on its own. However, it is implementing a Central Sector umbrella scheme- Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) for overall growth and development of food processing sector since 2016-17. Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI provides mostly credit linked financial assistance (capital subsidy) in the form of grants-in-aid for setting up of food processing / preservation industries to eligible applicants selected through Expression of Interest issued from time to time on SAMPADA Portal. PMKSY is not any region or state specific but demand driven and is implemented across the country including in the state of Odisha. The details of projects approved in Odisha under the component schemes of PMKSY are enclosed at **Annexure**.

Also as part of the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Initiative, MoFPI is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme-PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) for providing financial, technical and business support for setting up/upgradation of 2 lakh micro food processing enterprises through credit linked subsidy during five years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an outlay of Rs. 10,000 cr. Out of this, a total of 5201 units have been allocated to Odisha for five years.
