**CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANIES**

**5361. SHRIMATI MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI:**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES **भारी उद्योग मंत्री** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the number of car manufacturing companies shut down in India from March 2020 to January 2022;
- (b) whether the Government has assessed the reasons for their shut down and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the incentives provided by the Government to retain car manufacturers in India?

**(a):** As per information received from Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM), no car manufacturing company has completely shut down its operations in India, for the said period. However, in September 2021, Ford India announced that they would cease manufacturing vehicles for sale in India while manufacturing of vehicles for exports will wind down at Sanand Vehicle assembly plant by 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2021, and Chennai engine and vehicle assembly plants by 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2022.
