**Promotion of Fisheries in Madhya Pradesh**

**5399. DR. DHAL SINGH BISEN:**

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Government of Madhya Pradesh has availed the benefits of the Government schemes to promote fisheries and if so, the details thereof along with the farmers engaged in fisheries who have availed these benefits and the amount of assistance provided in this regard during the last five years, district wise; and
- (b) the details of fish production during the said period and the difference noticed therein after introduction of these schemes on fish production?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING**

**(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

(a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during a period of 5 years from 2015-16 to 2019-20 implemented a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries for development of fisheries in the country including in Madhya Pradesh. Under this CSS, Central financial assistance of Rs.49.88 crore was released to the Government of Madhya Pradesh for development of fisheries and aquaculture in the State.

The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is now implementing a flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with highest ever estimated investment of ₹20,050 crore in fisheries sector for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21 as a part of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Package. The Department of Fisheries, Government of India during the financial years 2020-21 and 2021-22 has accorded approval to the fisheries development proposals of Government of Madhya Pradesh at a total cost of Rs.323.73 crore with central share of Rs.99.70 crore and released central financial assistance of Rs.79.58 crore to the State Government for development of fisheries in the State. The Government of Madhya Pradesh has reported that fish production has been increased from 1.15 lakh tonne during 2015-16 to 2.49 lakh tonne during 2020-22 and as such fish production has enhanced by 1.34 lakh tonne during the period of implementation of above said schemes.

The district-wise details of financial assistance provided during last five years from fiscal year 2017-18 to 2021-22 as reported by the Government of Madhya Pradesh are furnished at Annexure-I.
