#### **5639. SHRI ABDUL KHALEQUE:**

#### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has considered to construct a statue of Col. Guru Prasad Das, the inventor of Rail Vacuum Brake, at Barpeta;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of trains including local trains from Guwahati to different destinations within and outside the State during the pre-Covid/post-Covid period?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI ASHWINI VAISHNAW)

- (a) & (b): As per Railways' extant policy, Railway premises are not considered appropriate place for installation of statues, plaques, memorials and murals of persons of eminence.
- (c): Prior to discontinuation of regular passenger carrying train services owing to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, 35 pairs of train services served Guwahati. At present, Guwahati is being served by 32 pairs of trains. Besides train services are being restored in a phased manner.
