- (a) the number of Startups that has been supported under the Entrepreneurs-in-Residence (EIR) programme of the National Initiative for Developing and Harnessing Innovations (NIDHI) programme by the Department of Science and Technology (DST);
- (b) whether grants has been disbursed under this program to aspiring entrepreneurs or Startups; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) In accordance with the objectives of National Initiative for Developing and Harnessing Innovations (NIDHI) Entrepreneurs-in-Residence (EIR) program, 410 individuals aspiring to be entrepreneur or form a startup have been supported under this program. The grant is provided in the form of fellowship to the selected individuals, aspiring entrepreneurs, known as EIR fellows.
- (c) The NIDHI EIR support recipients (aspiring entrepreneurs- EIR fellows) are eligible for a maximum grant up to Rs. 30,000/- per month for a period of 12 months which is extendable up to 18 months in deserving case. The total quantum of support to the selected EIR fellows is limited to Rs. 3,60,000/-. The NIDHI EIR program is operated through a set of Technology Business Incubators across the country.
