- (b) the number of children with full immunization under the age of five years in NER, Statewise;
- (c) the number of malnourished children under the age of five years in NER, State-wise;
- (d) the number of stunted children under the age of five years in NER, State-wise; and
- (e) funds allocated for child health care to North-Eastern States under Central Government Schemes during the last five years, State-wise?
