**INCREASE IN MILK PRODUCTION**

- (a) the quantum of increase in milk production every year alongwith the details of milk production during the current year and the last six year, State-wise;
- (b) the position of India in milk production in the world; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to increase milk production and details thereof?

(a): The details of milk production along with quantum of increase for the country during last six years are given as under:

(b): India is at the First position in the world in milk production. (Source: Economic Survey report 2021-22 and Food and Agriculture Organization-STAT)

(c): In order to enhance milk production in the country the Government of India has been implementing following major Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored schemes:

- i. Rashtriya Gokul mission: This scheme has been implementing since 2014 with the aim of development and conservation of indigenous breeds, genetic upgradation of bovine population and enhancement of milk production and productivity of bovines thereby making milk production more remunerative to farmers engaged in dairying.
- ii. National Programme for Dairy Development: It has aim to enhance quality of milk and milk products and increase share of organized milk procurement.
- iii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund.
- iv. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations: This scheme is engaged in dairy activities and this scheme was approved to provide working capital loan to State Cooperatives and Federations.
