STATUS OF PMFME SCHEME

954. SHRI SHANKAR LALWANI:

Will the MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme;
- (b) the list of beneficiaries under the said scheme in Madhya Pradesh, district-wise;
- (c) the criteria fixed by the Government for availing benefits of PMFME Scheme; and
- (d) the manner in which one can apply in this scheme?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a): The current status of PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme is as under:

(i). 35 States/ UTs have nominated State Nodal Agencies (SNAs) and also constituted State Level Approval Committees (SLACs) and District Level Committees (DLCs). State of West Bengal is yet to decide on participation in the scheme.

(ii). One District One Products (ODOPs) for 710 Districts have been approved in 35 States / UTs.

(iii). Seed Capital amounting to Rs.127.46 crore released for 43,118 Self Help Group (SHG) Members.

(iv). 75 Incubation Centers have been approved with an outlay of Rs. 200.03 crore.

(v). Under Marketing & Branding component of the scheme, 7 One District One Products (ODOPs) brands have been launched in the States of Bihar, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Jammu & Kashmir and Haryana and 2 proposals from Punjab and Maharashtra have been approved.

(vi). For capacity building, 2 National Level Technical Institutes (NLTIs) and 42 State Level Technical Institutes (SLTIs) in 35 States/UTs have been nominated.

(vii). 760 Product Training Modules developed containing Presentations, Videos, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) and Course content/ Handbook for the benefit of beneficiaries.

(viii). 426 Master Trainers of 34 States/UTs, 580 District Level Trainers of 23 States/UTs and 1114 beneficiaries from 13 States/UTs have been trained. 932 District Resource Persons (DRPs) have been appointed to provide handholding support to beneficiaries.

(ix). Grants-in-aid to 1793 beneficiaries have been sanctioned out of 14,565 applications submitted.
