Will the Minister of **FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING**
मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has an estimate on India's competitiveness at the global level in fisheries sector;
- (b) the details of production and export of marine products in the last three years, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of steps undertaken by the Government for expansion of marine exports?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING:

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) India is one of the largest fish producing countries in the world and shares 7.96 % in the global production. The fish production in India has registered an average annual growth of 7.00% during last 5 years and stood at all-time high of 147.24 lakh metric tons during the year 2020-21. The Gross Value Added (GVA) of fisheries sector in the national economy during the 2019-20 stood at Rs 2,22,611 crores (current basic price) which constituted 1.21% of the total National GVA and 6.56% share of Agricultural GVA.

In addition, as per GLOBEFISH, FAO, India is the fourth largest exporter of seafood, largest supplier of frozen shrimp to USA, third largest supplier of shrimp to the European Union, fourth largest supplier of frozen shrimp to Japan and largest supplier of cephalopods to the European Union.

(b) The State-wise and year-wise details of total fish production in the country during last 03 years are furnished at Annexure I. The State-wise and year-wise details of export of marine products in the country for the last three years as reported by the Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) are furnished at Annexure II.

(c) The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during 2020-21, as a part of Atma Nirbhar Bharat Package has rolled out a flagship scheme "Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India" with

highest ever investment of Rs. 20050 crore in the fisheries sector for its implementation for a period of five years from the financial year 2020-21 to 2024-25 in all States/Union Territories. PMMSY intends to address critical gaps in fish production, productivity, quality, technology, post-harvest infrastructure and management, modernisation and strengthening of value chain, reduction of post-harvest losses, traceability etc. The PMMSY eventually targets creation of critical infrastructure for fishery production with focus on export-oriented species.
