- (a) & (b): Government has decided to set up 'Indian Institute of Heritage' (IIH) as a Deemed to be University as per UGC (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2019 at Noida, Gautam Budha Nagar, Uttar Pradesh with the purpose of providing higher education and research in the fields related to Indian heritage and its conservation. IIH will impart post graduate and research degree in History of Arts, Conservation, Museology, Archival Studies, Archaeology, Preventive Conservation, among others
- (c) & (d): Yes Sir, The Indian Institute of Heritage is being established to meet the human resources requirement in the entire Cultural Sector including Museology. New Education Policy endeavours to incorporate culture as an integral part of educational curriculum. This shall promote the study of Museology at higher level.
