STATEMENT IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*121 FOR ANSWER ON 26.07.2022 REGARDING "TRAINING TO PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES".

- (a): At present, the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) is providing training to security personnel of State security agencies as well as Public Sector Undertakings. The CISF has held consultation with Central Association of Private Security Industry (CAPSI) to take forward the issue of training to Private Security Agencies.
- (b): CISF is presently deployed in 12 private sector institutions/companies. Details of CISF deployment at private sector institutions/companies are as under:
