(a) The salient features of the Jan Shikshan Sansthan scheme are:

- i. Imparting skill development training in non-formal mode to non-literates, neo-literates, and school drop-outs upto 12th standard in the age-group of 15-45 in rural areas and urban slums.
- ii. Providing skill training to the beneficiaries at their door step with minimum infrastructure and resources.
- iii. Improving the quality of life of the target group belonging to disadvantaged sections of the society especially women, SC, ST and Minority by making them self-reliant through self-employment/wage employment.
- iv. Creating awareness on health, personal hygiene, education, financial literacy, environment women issues with the help of local community.
