- (a) whether the Government is making efforts to train the teachers in innovation, entrepreneurship, IPR, idea generation etc. under "School Innovation Ambassador Training Programme"; and
- (b) if so, the details of the outcomes achieved since the launch of the scheme in terms of number of teachers trained in Madhya Pradesh, particularly in districts of Panna, Katni, Chhatarpur?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO THE PARTS (a) AND (b) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 211 FOR ANSWER ON 01.08.2022 ASKED BY SHRI VISHNU DATT SHARMA, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT REGARDING SCHOOL INNOVATION AMBASSADOR TRAINING PROGRAMME.

(a): Yes Sir, The School Innovation Ambassador Training Program (SIATP) was launched by the Hon'ble Education Minister on 16th July 2021. The program is being implemented jointly by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell in coordination with Tribal Affairs Ministry, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). The Principal/ Vice Principal of the school has to register their school on SIATP website (https://sia.mic.gov.in/) and has to nominate teachers from their school to undergo this detailed free of cost training.

This 72 hours training aims at strengthening the mentoring capacity of teachers for nurturing and handholding innovative and creative ideas from students.

The teachers are trained on the following five modules:

- i. Design Thinking & Innovation
- ii. Idea generation & Idea hand-holding
- iii. Intellectual Property Rights
- iv. Entrepreneurship & Product / Prototype Development
- v. Finance, HR, and Sales

The trained teachers will create a committed human resource in schools to create a culture of innovation, ideation, and entrepreneurship.

Under School Innovation Ambassador Training Program, 16,224 nos. of school teachers have been trained in Intellectual Property Rights; 14,462 trained in Entrepreneurship and Product/ prototype Development; 30,871 in Design Thinking and Innovation; 14,787 in Finance, HR & Sales and 15,338 trained in Idea Generation and Idea Handholding.

(b): In state of Madhya Pradesh, 627 numbers of teachers have been trained in Intellectual Property Rights; 564 trained in Entrepreneurship and Product/ prototype Development; 1472 in Design Thinking and Innovation; 570 in Finance, HR & Sales, and 605 trained in Idea Generation and Idea Handholding. Following is the district-wise distribution for Panna, Katni, and Chhatarpur:
