- (b) the details of funds allocated/released for these projects during the last five years and the current year, year-wise and State/district-wise;
- (c) the total amount of funds spent on higher education projects during the aforesaid period, State/district-wise;
- (d) whether the Government is monitoring the impact of such educational projects/schemes and if so, the details thereof for the last three years; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by Government for effective implementation of such educational projects in the country?

(a) to (c) The educational projects in the country to promote and improve the educational system in collaboration with State Governments are done under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) of Ministry of Education. RUSA seeks to improve the overall quality of existing State higher educational institutions by ensuring their conformity to prescribed norms and standards and adoption of accreditation as mandatory quality assurance framework; correcting regional imbalances by facilitating access to high quality institutions in rural and semi urban areas. RUSA supports colleges and universities across the country under various components such as Equity Initiatives, Infrastructure grants to universities, Infrastructure grants to colleges, etc. Under RUSA scheme, there is no provision to allocate fund year-wise and state-wise, however the number of units and amount approved for various units (state-wise including Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra and Rajasthan) under the scheme are given at Annexure-I. The State-wise details of the funds released during the last five years and current year to the educational projects under RUSA scheme is at Annexure-II.
