INTER-LINKING OF VILLAGES UNDER PMGSY

*221. SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct link routes and bridges between the rural institutions in the third phase of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) after inter-linking the villages of the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof for the State of Maharashtra relating to the third phase of PMGSY?

ANSWER MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH)

(a) & (b) A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

The statement referred to in reply to Parts (a) to (b) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. *221 due for answer on 02.08.2022.

(a & b) The Government of India has approved Phase-III of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) with an aim to consolidate 1,25,000 km Through Routes and Major Rural Links connecting habitations, inter-alia to Gramin Agricultural Markets, Higher Secondary Schools and Hospitals.

The State of Maharashtra has been allocated 6,550 km road length under PMGSY-III. The state has already been sanctioned 430 road works of 2,925.92 km road length under PMGSY-III.

Pre-Empowered Committee meeting for 577 roads of 3,492.74 km length has been conducted. Compliance report on observations of Pre-EC is awaited from the State Govt.
