### **Overseas Training for Athletes**

### \*237. SHRI THIRUNAVUKKARASAR SU:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned huge amount of money to athletes for overseas training;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of athletes who went abroad for training along with the amount spent thereon during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has proposed to extend overseas training for the coming years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 237 TO BE ANSWERED ON 02-08-2022 ASKED BY SHRI THIRUNAVUKKARASAR SU REGARDING OVERSEAS TRAINING FOR ATHLETES

(a) to (d): Yes, under the 'Target Olympic Podium Scheme' (TOPS), Government has sanctioned money to athletes for overseas training. The details of athletes who went abroad for training along with the amount spent thereon during each of last three years and current year is given in <u>Annexure-I</u>.

Under Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations (NSFs), the recognized NSFs are provided with financial assistance for National Coaching Camps, foreign training, equipments, coaches and support staff etc. towards preparation of Indian Sportspersons for the major International Competitions such as Olympic, Paralympic, Asian, Para Asian, Commonwealth Games.

The details of players provided financial assistance towards their International training under Scheme of Assistance to NSFs from the year 2019-20 onwards is given in Annexure - II.

Overseas training to players under TOPS and other schemes is now a regular and ongoing feature to prepare them for international events. In fact, there is policy to send the NCOEs athletes of SAI for foreign training/exposure, where adequate exposure in foreign competitions is not available. A total of 10 athletes have benefited from this ongoing scheme.
