(a) to (d) Survey for new Broad Gauge line between Bodhan-Biloli-Mukhed-Latur Road (134.55 km) was completed in 2019-20. The proposed railway line passes through the States of Telangana and Maharashtra. As per survey report, the project is unremunerative and having low traffic potential.

Therefore, Govt. of Telangana and Maharashtra were approached for sharing cost of the project. However, the State Government consent has not been received. Hence, project could not be taken forward.

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
