(a) to (e) Currently, the Government is not implementing any programme for promotion of cooking based on renewable energy sources.

All the willing households in the 24 identified unelectrified villages in Dharni & Chikhaldara talukas of the Amravati Constituency of Maharashtra have been electrified through installation of solar energy systems under Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana (SAUBHAGYA) Scheme of the Ministry of Power. The village-wise details of the households electrified under the Scheme is placed at **Annexure**.
