- (a) the details of funds allocated/granted/released under various schemes of AYUSH across the country, State-wise including Thane district in Maharashtra and Davangere district in Karnataka during the last five years, year-wise;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated to Government and non-Government institutes under the schemes, State/ UT-wise and district-wise including Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka;
- (c) the time by which the Government is likely to release the remaining funds to Maharashtra and Karnataka; and
- (d) the number of AYUSH doctors providing their services at present along with the diseases being treated under the said schemes, State/UT-wise?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO.287* FOR 5TH AUGUST, 2022**

(a) The details of the Budget allocated to various schemes under the Ministry of Ayush across the country in the last five years are placed as an **Annexure I**

Ministry of Ayush is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) through State/UT Governments including Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka for development and promotion of AYUSH systems and grant-in-aid is provided to them as per the proposals received in their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). Under NAM, as per the proposals received from the State/UTs including Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka through SAAPs, total grant-in-aid of Rs. 229605.043lakhs have been released during the last five years for implementation of various activities as per the provision of NAM guidelines. **However, under NAM, no grant-in-aid is released district-wise.** The State/UT wise status of released grant-in-aid during the last five years is furnished in **Annexure II**.

National Medicinal Plants Board, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India is implementing Central Sector Scheme on “Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants” wherein following activities are supported:

- (i) *In-situ* conservation / *Ex-situ* conservation
- (ii) Livelihood linkages with Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs) / Panchayats / Van Panchayats / Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs) / Self Help Groups (SHGs).
- (iii) IEC activities like Training / workshops / Seminars/ Conferences etc.
- (iv) Research & Development.
- (v) Promotion, marketing and trade of medicinal plants produce.

Till date, National Medicinal Plants Board, Ministry of Ayush has released an amount of **Rs. 23491.64**lakh throughout the country including Maharashtra and Karnataka under Central Sector Scheme for Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants from the financial year 2017-18 to 2021-22 (including current financial year). The detail of funds released under Central Sector Scheme for Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants from the financial year 2017-18 to 2021-22 is given at **Annexure III**.

(b) The details of the funds allocated to Government and non-Government Institutes under the various schemes of Ministry of Ayush, State/UT-wise and district-wise including Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka are placed as an **Annexure IV**

(c) As per the issued guidelines of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, eligible amount as per the provision of National Ayush Mission (NAM) guideline has been released to the State Government of Maharashtra and Karnataka against their submitted State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs).

(d) Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility regarding deployment of Ayush Doctors and providing treatment in different diseases lies with the respective State/UT Governments. However as per the statistical survey of Ministry of Ayush the total number of registered AYUSH practitioners in India is **7,12,132** (As on 01.01.2020) and the numbers of AYUSH doctors State/UT wise are placed as an **Annexure V**.
