### †\*47. SHRIMATI RANJEETA KOLI: SHRI SUMEDHANAND SARASWATI:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the foodgrains procured by the Government gets damaged by fungus and worms during monsoon due to improper storage;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the quantity of foodgrains getting destroyed in the country every year as per the report of Food and Agriculture Organisation;
- (d) whether the Government has any information about transparency being maintained during the auction and distribution of the damaged foodgrains; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

# A N S W E R MINISTER OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY, CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION AND TEXTILES (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF THE STARRED QUESTION NO.47 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 20.07.2022 IN THE LOK SABHA.

- (a) & (b): There are no such instances reported of Central Pool Foodgrains stocks (wheat and rice) getting damaged by fungus and worms during monsoon season due to improper storage.
- (c): Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations estimates data on food losses and not on foodgrains destroyed.
- (d) & (e): Food Corporation of India (FCI) disposes off damaged/nonissuable foodgrains stocks through Rate Running Contract (RRC) on accrual. The following steps are taken to bring transparency in disposal of damaged foodgrains during its auction and distribution:
  - (i) Non-issuable/damaged foodgrains are sold only to the "Registered Parties" registered with FCI for purchase of damaged foodgrains.
  - (ii) Wide Publicity is given by way of publication through *e-tender* on Central Public Procurement Portal and also uploaded on FCI Website.
  - (iii) All Registered parties are given intimation at the time of floating of tenders.
  - (iv) E-tendering procedure for all contracts with value above Rs 2 lakhs is followed.
  - (v) **E-payment system has been adopted.**
  - (vi) Concerned State Governments are informed about the movement with a request to ensure that the foodgrains are not misused by anyone.
