FUNDS FOR AYUSH

1059. SHRI D.M. KATHIR ANAND:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has sanctioned any funds for the development of AYUSH infrastructure in Tamil Nadu;

(b) if so, the details of the funds allocated in the last five years, year-wise, hospital-wise;

(c) the steps taken by the Government to promote research and related activities pertaining to AYUSH medicinal system; and

(d) the funds allocated during the last five years by the union Government in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) & (b) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM), provisionshave been made for financial assistance for upgradation of standalone AYUSH Hospitals and Dispensaries, establishment of AYUSH Health and Wellness Centres, setting up of 50/30/10 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals, setting up of new AYUSH Educational Institutions and upgradation AYUSH Educational Institutions in the country including Tamil Nadu.As per the proposal received from State Government of Tamil Nadu through the State Annual Action Plan (SAAP), the details of funds approved/allocated for infrastructural development under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) toTamil Nadu during thelast five years, year and hospital-wiseare furnished at **Annexure-I.**

(c)& (d) Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM), Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH)and Central Council for Research in Siddha (CCRS)are autonomous organizations under Ministry of Ayush for research including medicinal research in Ayurveda, Unani, Homoeopathy and Siddha system of Medicine respectively. CCRAS, CCRUM, CCRH and CCRS are working towards the scientific validation in the concerned system of medicines through clinical research, drug research, medicinal plants research, fundamental research, literary research and documentation. The status of funds allocated during the last five years in CCRAS, CCRUM, CCRH and CCRS is furnished in **Annexure-II**.
