Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is planning to open critical care /super speciality hospitals in all districts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which said hospitals are likely to be opened;
- (c) whether the Government is also planning to open health centres at the block levels in the country; and
- (d) if so, the time by which such new centres are likely be to be opened?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) & (b): Under PM Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM), 50 to 100 bedded Critical Care Hospitals are provisioned to be established in all the districts with more than 5 lakh population, from the financial year 2021-22 to financial year 2025-26. Remaining districts will have Referral linkages. Further, 12 Central Government Hospitals/ Institutions have also been included under PM-ABHIM for setting up of 150 bedded Critical Care Hospital Blocks.
- (c) & (d): Under PM-ABHIM, Block Public Health Units (BPHUs) are provisioned to be established in all the 3382 blocks of 8 High Focus States and 3 Hill States (Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Himachal Pradesh, UT-Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand), from the financial year 2021-22 to financial year 2025-26.
