Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish new Government Medical Colleges in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Odisha, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) whether the Government has noted that the absence of a Government Medical colleges in districts with limited medical facilities affects the health of the people as well as the education of medical aspirants; and
- (d) if so, the details of the steps being taken by the Government to address the inadequacy of medical facilities in such districts?

(a) to (d) The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for ‘Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals’ with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college. Under the Scheme, 157 new medical colleges have been approved in the country including Odisha, West Bengal and Uttar Pradesh in three phases and 72 are already functional. The details are at **Annexure-I**.

Further, in order to provide medical facilities and education to medical aspirants in various parts of the country, the Government has approved, setting up of 22 AIIMS and 75 projects of upgradation of GMCIs under PMSSY in various phases. The details are at **Annexure-II**.

The Government has taken various steps to further increase the availability of doctors in the country, particularly in underserved regions. The number of UG seats have increased from 51,348 before 2014 to 91927 seats as on date which is an increase of 79%.The numbers of PG seats have increased by 93% from 31,185 seats before 2014 to 60202 seats.
