Fertilizer Factories in Rajasthan

1130: SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH JOSHI:

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of fertilizer factories and quantum of fertilizer production in Rajasthan at present;
- (b) whether the Government is considering to set up new fertilizer factories in Rajasthan; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof, location-wise?

ANSWER

(a): There are 4 major fertilizer factories of Urea in Rajasthan namely Chambal Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd at Gadepan-I, Gadepan- II, Gadepan-III and Shriram Fertilizers & Chemicals at Kota and the quantum of Urea production in Rajasthan during 2021-22 and 2022-23 (up to June 2022) are as under:

(b) to (c): No Sir. Government of India has no such proposal to set up new Urea plant in Rajasthan. However, Government of India has mandated revival of five closed fertilizer plants of Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited (FCIL) and Hindustan Fertilizer Corporation Limited (HFCL) namely Talcher, Ramagundam, Gorakhpur and Sindri plants of FCIL and Barauni plant of HFCL by formation of Joint Venture Companies of nominated PSUs for setting up new Urea Ammonia plants of 12.7 Lakh metric tonne per annum capacity each. The fertilizer plants at Ramagundam and Gorakhpur have already been commissioned. Further, Cabinet in its meeting held on 21.05.2015 inter-alia approved setting up of New urea plant of 8.646 LMT/PA capacity in the existing premises of BVFCL, which has been notified by Department of Fertilizers vide OM dated 12.06.2015.
