Registration of Manufacturers/Vendors in PSUs

1160. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has simplified the enlistment/registration of manufacturers/vendors/ contractors/suppliers/services in all Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of enlistments done during each of the last five years, category and product-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) : The Government has set up Government e-Marketplace (GeM) as the National Public Procurement Portal for providing procurement of goods and services by Central and State Government Organizations. The Department of Public Enterprises has instructed all Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) to mandatorily onboard the GeM portal and procure commonly used goods and services from GeM as well as invite sellers to onboard GeM. Any seller can register their products and services on GeM procurement platform. GeM had collected details of enlisted sellers from CPSEs and registered them on GeM portal as a seller. The details of new sellers onboarded on GeM portal across various categories during last five years are as under:

Year	Number of categories	Number of new sellers onboarded
2017-18	10,355	89,273
2018-19	10,827	1,32,528
2019-20	11,016	1,57,982
2020-21	11,441	10,76,063
2021-22	10,531	26,77,319

As per available information, the procurement by CPSEs through GeM has increased from Rs. 7,027.3 crore in 2020-21 to Rs. 45,971 crore in 2021-22.
