- (a) whether the Government has proposed to notify Male Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary in Karnataka as Tiger Reserve and if so, the details and the current status thereof;
- (b) the details of forest area identified as core and buffer zone; and
- (c) the details of number of tigers identified in this wildlife sanctuary along with the total number of tigers in Karnataka according to latest tiger census?

- (a) Approval of National Tiger Conservation Authority has been accorded to the proposal of Karnataka State Government to declare the Malai Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary as Tiger Reserve.
- (b) The details of core and buffer area of the proposed Malai Mahadeshwara Tiger Reserve are at **Annexure-I**.
- (c) 524 tigers have been reported in Karnataka, including 8 tigers in Malai Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary, as per the Status of Tigers, Co-predators and Prey in India, 2018.
