- (a) whether the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) under the framework of National Clean Air Programme and XV Finance Commission grants are mandated to converge financial resources from ongoing schemes/programmes/missions;
- (b) if so, the list of such schemes/programmes/missions of the Central Government;
- (c) whether the Government maintain the records of the quantum of funds converged by the ULBs under various schemes/programmes/missions to check effective implementation of NCAP; and
- (d) if so, the details of different schemes and funds converged along with the total amount, district-wise?
