1279. SHRI T.N. PRATHAPAN:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has the data of population of tribal people in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has the data of tribal people who are elected into the Legislative Councils/Assemblies/ Parliament and the number of tribal representatives in these legislative spaces;
- (d) the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (e) the number of tribal legislators in the country in last 10 years; and
- (f) the details of the proportional ratio between tribal population and tribal legislators?

(a) to (b): The population of Scheduled Tribes (STs) in the country, as per Census 2011 is 10.45 crore. State/UT -wise population of Scheduled Tribes in India as per Census 2011 is given at **Annexure I**.

(c) to (f): As per information received from Election Commission of India, State-wise Number of ST Candidates Elected in General Election to Lok Sabha in 2014 and 2019 in all Seats including General and ST and Number of ST Candidates elected in General Election to Legislative Assemblies of States/UTs in all seats including General and ST is given at **Annexure II**.
