Framework for Higher Education

1374. SHRI BRIJENDRA SINGH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the new framework for higher education as envisaged by the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020, has been formulated;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the time by which it is likely to be formulated;
- (c) whether the phased implementation of NEP in higher educational institutes has started in Haryana; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): The University Grants Commission (UGC) has informed that it has developed Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit in Academic Programmes and Educational Framework for Global Citizenship in Higher Education and notified the UGC (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) Regulation, 2021. The UGC has also prepared the draft National Higher Education Qualifications Framework.

(c) & (d): As per National Education Policy (NEP), 2020, implementation of the Policy requires multiple initiatives and actions, which will have to be taken by different bodies in a synchronized and systematic manner. The policy provides different timelines as well as principles and methodology for its implementation. Accordingly, Ministry of Education, other Ministries/Departments, State/UT Governments and implementing agencies under their purview have started taking initiatives towards implementation of NEP, 2020.
