#### SKILL TRAINING TO UNSKILLED WORKERS UNDER MGNREGS

#### 1398. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the goals and objectives of the Ministry for imparting skill training to the unskilled workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS);
- (b) whether any targets had been fixed by the Ministry to provide skill training during 2020-21; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the number of workers for which targets were fixed for skill training, State-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) The Government of India has launched "Project UNNATI" in December 2019 which intends to upgrade the skill-base of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) workers, and thereby improve their livelihoods, so that they can move from the current partial employment to full employment through either self employment or wage employment. The Project aims to enhance the skill base of 2 lakh Mahatma Gandhi NREGS beneficiaries.
- (b) & (c) Yes, Sir. State/UT-wise detail of target fixed under Project "UNNATI" in financial year 2020-21 is given at **Annexure.**
