DELAY OF CENSUS

1508. SHRI POCHA BRAHMANANDA REDDY:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that due to the delay of the census, updated data regarding schemes is absent which means that intended beneficiaries are being ignored;

(b) if so, whether the Government is considering any interim measures to tide over the situation;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether the Government has received any requests for extension of schemes based on newer data collected by the States;

(e) if so, the details thereof including the steps taken by the Government in response to the requests; and

(f) the time by which the Government proposes to complete the census?

(a) to (f): Population Projections for India and States/Union Territories for 2011-2036, based on Census 2011 data, are available in the Report of the Technical Group on Population Projections published by National Commission on Population, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. The intent of the Government for conducting Census 2021 was notified in Gazette of India on 28th March, 2019. Due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic, the Census 2021 and the related field activities have been postponed until further orders.
