ROADS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PMGSY

1526. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY);
- (b) the details of the roads constructed in kilometres, their cost and the number of villages linked with metalled roads through these roads under the said yojana in the State of Jharkhand during the last three years, Statewise;
- (c) whether any target has been fixed thereunder for the next three years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) The Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY-I) was launched in the year 2000 with an objective to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations of designated population size.

In the year 2013, PMGSY-II was launched for upgradation of selected Through Routes and Major Rural Links (MRLs) with a target to upgrade 50,000 Km in various States and Union Territories.

Subsequently, in 2016, Road Connectivity Project for Left Wing Extremism Affected Areas (RCPLWEA) was launched for construction/upgradation of strategically important roads, as a separate vertical under PMGSY.

In the year 2019, Government launched PMGSY-III for consolidation of 1,25,000 Km Through Routes and Major Rural Links connecting habitations, inter-alia, to Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs), Higher Secondary Schools and Hospitals.

- (b) All the roads constructed under PMGSY are all-weather roads. Moreover, the unit for PMGSY scheme is a habitation and not a village. The state-wise details of roads constructed (in km), expenditure incurred (including state share) and habitations connected during the last three years is given at **Annexure-I**. Further, the details of roads constructed under various interventions/ verticals of PMGSY can be accessed at **omms.nic.in->Proposals->Statewise List of Roads**.
- (c) & (d) Physical targets to states are fixed every year at the start of Financial Year. The state-wise physical target, set for the current Financial Year 2022-23 is given at **Annexure-II**.
