Funds for National Education Policy

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total fund allocated for National Education Policy (NEP) since its adoption for its proper implementations;
- (b) the total fund spent / utilized so far for NEP and the success achieved by the Government till June, 2022; and
- (c) the details of programme to complete technicalities and to educate teachers before the implementation of NEP?

(a) and (b): Various schemes/projects/programmes run by Ministry of Education have been aligned with National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020). The budget for education across the country is allocated by the Centre and the State / UT Governments. Details of total Budget Allocation and Expenditure of Ministry of Education are given in table below:

In this Samagam, Vice Chancellors of Central/State/Deemed/Private Universities, Directors / Heads of Higher Educational Institutions, Principals / Faculties of Colleges, Educationists, Policy-makers etc participated.
