### SOIL TESTING LABORATORIES

1577. SHRI GUMAN SINGH DAMOR:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of laboratories set up for the soil testing and the number of laboratories working in Ratlam, Jhabua and Alirajpur districts of my Parliamentary Constituency;
- (b) the details and the number of soil samples tested and the cards made in these functional laboratories during each of the last three years, district-wise;
- (c) the number of posts sanctioned for the functioning of these laboratories and the number of posts filled up out of the sanctioned strength along with the details of the budget sanctioned for the operation of one laboratory;
- (d) the names of programmes being run by the Krishi Vigyan Kendra to increase the income of the farmers; and
- (e) the manner in which these programmes are monitored along with the details of the work done by Krishi Vigyan Kendras in my Parliamentary Constituency?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a): As of now, one soil testing laboratory in Ratlam district and one soil testing laboratory in Jhabua district are working. In addition to this, 16 more laboratories for soil testing have been sanctioned in Ratlam, Jhabua and Alirajpur. Details are at **Annexure –I**.

(b): The details of soils sample collected, soil sample tested and Soil Health Cardsdistributed to the farmers in these districts of Ratlam, Jhabua & Alirajpur during year 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 are at **Annexure-II**.

(c): The details of number of posts sanctioned and filled up are at Annexure -III and

details of budget sanctioned for operation of these laboratories are at **Annexure –IV**.

(d) & (e): The Government has set up 731 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) in the Country with mandate of technology assessment and demonstration for its application and capacity development. The activities of KVKs include On-farm testing to assess the location specificity of technology under various farming systems; frontline demonstration to establish the production potential of improved agricultural technologies on the farmers' fields; Capacity development of farmers and extension personnel for knowledge and skill up gradation; and production of quality seeds, planting materials and other technology inputs for availability to the farmers. In order to develop awareness of improved agricultural technology among the farmers, a number of extension activities are taken up by the KVKs. KVKs of Ratlam, Jhabua and Alirajpur districts have conducted 897 on-farm trials and 1320 frontline demonstrations; trained 8371 farmers and extension personnel; and produced 565.36 quintals quality seeds and 50344 quality planting materials during last one year. The KVKs also organized extension activities with the participation of 15372 farmers.

A number of mechanisms are in place for monitoring of KVKs which include holding of Scientific Advisory Committee meetings, Annual State and Zonal Workshops, Activity Specific Training-cum-Workshops, site visits by the Officers/Scientists of Agricultural Technology Application Research Institutes, Directorates of Extension of Agricultural Universities and ICAR Headquarters; linkage and convergence meetings/discussions and review by Quinquennial Review Teams.
