STOPPAGE OF TRAINS AT KASGANJ

1709. SHRI RAJVEER SINGH (RAJU BHAIYA): SHRI BHOLA SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to launch a new train with stoppage at Kasganj, Uttar Pradesh going to Delhi via Agra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Ministry has received any request in this regard;
- (d) if so, the action taken thereon; and
- (e) the number of trains passing through Kasganj, category wise, frequency-wise and stoppage wise?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d) No, Sir. At present, no proposal for introduction of new train from Delhi with stoppage at Kasganj (via Agra) is under consideration. Representation inter-alia for introduction of direct train service between Kasganj and Delhi has been received. The same has been examined but is not feasible, at present, due to operational constraints including terminal constraints in Delhi area. However, introduction of new train services is an ongoing process on Indian Railways, subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, commercial validity, availability of resources, etc.
- (e) At present, Kasganj station is being served by 13 pairs of Passenger Special services (all daily services) and 16 pairs of Mail/Express services (09 pairs of weekly, 01 pair of bi-weekly, 03 pairs of tri-weekly and 03 pairs of daily services).
