- (b) whether the display screens have been installed at the said railway stations for the convenience of the passengers;**

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.1723 BY SHRI HEMANT SRIRAM PATIL TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 27.07.2022 REGARDING ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR PASSENGER AMENITIES**

**(a) The details of allocation of funds and expenditure incurred for development and maintenance of stations including for passenger amenities are maintained zonal Railway-wise not State-wise or station-wise. Passenger amenities are generally funded under Plan Head – 53 ‘Customer Amenities’. Hingoli, Nanded, Kinwat, Sahashtrakund, Himayatnagar and Basmat railway stations fall under South Central Railway. The details of funds allocated and expenditure incurred by South Central Railway for development and maintenance of stations including for passenger amenities under Plan Head-53 ‘Customer Amenities’, during the last three years and current year are as under: -**

**(d) Kinwat, Sahasrakund, Himayatnagar and Basmat stations are Non-Suburban Group (NSG)-5 category stations. As per guidelines for passenger amenities, provision of Train Indication Board is done at NSG-1 to NSG-3 under Minimum Essential Amenities and Coach Guidance System/ Coach Indication Boards is done at NSG-1 to NSG-4 category Railway Station under recommended passenger amenities.**
