RESERVATION IN PROMOTION TO DIFFERENTLY ABLED

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has made any provision for reservation in promotions to the differently-abled personnel in the jobs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 has recommended reservation benefits to the persons with benchmark disabilities; and
- (d) if so, the details including the number of persons benefitted therefrom during the last three years, yearwise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Instructions have been issued for reservation in promotion to Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, vide Office Memorandum No. 36012/1/2020-Estt.(Res.-II), dated 17.05.2022.

(c) & (d): Yes, Sir. Section 34(1) of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 has provided reservation benefits to the following categories:

- (a) blindness and low vision;
- (b) deaf and hard of hearing;
- (c) locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy;
- (d) autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness;
- (e) multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deafblindness in the posts identified for each disabilities.

Year-wise details of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities appointed during the last three years, are as follows:
