Will the Minister of **PLANNING** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to identify/ designate more districts/blocks as Aspirational district;
- (b) if so, whether districts/blocks of Odisha have been included in this scheme, particularly Angul district; and
- (c) if not, the reason therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) At present, there is no proposal to include more districts under the Aspirational Districts Programme. In the recently held conference of the Chief Secretaries in Dharamshala from June 15 to June 17, 2022, States were requested to extend the template of the Aspirational Districts programme for accelerating development in backward blocks. As the blocks are the administrative units, working directly under the State Governments, they are to be identified by the States concerned.
- (b) Under the on-going Aspirational Districts Programme out of 112 districts identified all over the country, 10 districts are from Odisha. A list of these 10 Districts is provided in **Annexure-I.**
- (c) In 2018, 112 Aspirational Districts, were selected through a transparent process on the basis of published data. List of data sets and the weight attached to them for selection of these districts is attached in **Annexure II**. As stated, based on this selection process, 10 Districts of Odisha were covered under the Programme. Angul district was not included because at the time of selection of the Districts, other districts had shown lesser development than Angul District.
