(a) Water being a state subject, the works related to water resources development & management are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments as per their own resources and priorities. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by providing technical and financial assistance to them through various schemes and programmes.

Jal Shakti Abhiyan-I (JSA-I) was conducted in 2019 in 1592 blocks out of 2836 blocks in 256 water stressed districts of the country including that of Rajasthan and was expanded as "Jal Shakti Abhiyan:Catch the Rain" (JSA:CTR) in 2021 with the theme "Catch the Rain – Where it Falls When it Falls" to cover all the blocks of all districts (rural as well as urban areas) across the country. "Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain" (JSA:CTR) -2022 campaign, the third in the series of JSAs, has been launched on 29.3.2022 to cover all the blocks of all districts (rural as well as urban areas) across the country including Rajasthan. District-wise progress of water conservation and rainwater harvesting structures completed in Rajasthan under JSA:CTR from 22.3.2021 to 28.03.2022 and under JSA:CTR-2022 from 29.03.2022 to 25.07.2022 as uploaded on the JSA:CTR Portal (jsactr.mowr.gov.in) is attached as Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively.

Atal Bhujal Yojana (ATAL JAL) with World Bank funding has been launched for sustainable management of ground water in community participation in overexploited and water stressed areas of 7 States including Rajasthan.
