SCHEMES FOR DRINKING WATER

1844. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the centrally sponsored schemes under which clean piped water is being supplied to the villages in different States;
- (b) the funds spent in different States to provide drinking water in every village; and
- (c) whether the Government has set any target for making provision of clean drinking water to every village and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), a centrally sponsored scheme, is being implemented in partnership with States, since August, 2019 to make provision of potable tap water supply to every rural household of the country, by 2024. The estimated outlay of the mission is Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore out of which Central share is Rs. 2.08 lakh Crore.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission, 3.23 Crore rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, 6.62 Crore households have been provided with tap water connections in last 35 months. Thus, as on 22 July 2022, out of 19.14 Crore rural households in the country, around 9.85 Crore (51.52%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.
