ROAD ACCIDENTS ON NH-71

1854. SHRI MADDILA GURUMOORTHY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

सडक परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people injured, died and vehicles damaged due to raod accidents on National Highway-71 during each of the last five years and the current year;
- (b) whether the Government has taken any measures to prevent road accidents specifically on NH-71;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the present status of widening of said NH and its projected completion date;
- (e) whether the Government is considering a service road along the entire project length of said NH to minimise the volume of local traffic that impacts accidents; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) collects and compiles road accident data/information; however, disaggregated data for individual National Highways is not maintained separately.
- (b) & (c) Measures taken to prevent road accidents on NH-71 are as under:
 - 1) Identification of blackspot locations.
 - 2) Providing short term & long term treatment for rectification of blackspots.
 - 3) The stretch is being developed to 6 lane standards with some bypasses avoiding built-up area, flyovers, vehicular underpasses/overpasses at junctions, treating all at-grade

junctions as per IRC safety codes, improving geometrics both vertical and horizontal, etc.

- 4) Conducting Road Safety Awareness Programmes every year in January and educating School/College Children, highway users on measures to be taken while traveling/crossing the highway.
- (d) The present status of projects related to widening of NH-71 at various locations is as under:
