Energy Cooperation Agreements

- (a) whether new energy cooperation agreements, including a contract for Rosneft, signed in December 2021 would be impacted by the Ukraine-Russia crisis and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of India's State-owned firms with oil and gas assets in Russia;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the import of natural gas and crude oil from Russia would be impacted due to the Ukraine-Russia conflict and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of the import of natural gas and crude oil from Russia during the last five years, year-wise?

(a) to (d) : In the current situation of high volatility in global energy markets, Government of India is closely monitoring the situation. No adverse impact on hydrocarbon energy agreements is currently foreseen.

In Financial Year 2020-21, India imported 85% of its crude oil and 54% of natural gas requirement.

As per Petroleum Planning & Analysis Cell (PPAC), India's major sources of crude oil imports are Iraq, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Nigeria and USA.

Oil Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) import crude oil based on techno-commercial evaluation and economics of their refineries. Indian Oil & Gas Public Sector Undertakings had imported 558TMT crude oil from Russia in the year 2021-2022 out of total import of crude oil 211980 TMT.
