SMART CITY PROJECTS

NO. 1917 SHRI SANJAY BHATIA:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of cities included under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) and the details of the progress of work along with the funds allocated/spent on the said mission;
- (b) whether the Government has received proposal for overall development of slums in urban areas under SCM in Haryana and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the number of families rehabilitated out of the slums demolished under SCM in Haryana; and
- (d) the number of urban homeless families provided houses, State and smart city-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). As on 8 July 2022,

Government of India has released ₹ 30,751.41 crore for 100 Smart Cities, out of which ₹ 27,610.34 crore (90%) has been utilized. As on 8 July 2022, these Smart Cities have tendered out 7,822 projects worth ₹ 1,90,660 crore; work orders have been issued in 7,649 projects worth ₹ 1,80,996 crore; 4,085 projects worth ₹ 66,912 crore have been completed.

(b) to (d): Since Land and Colonization are State subjects, State Governments issue policies/guidelines for slum redevelopment/rehabilitation etc. Under SCM, projects including those related to slum re-development/rehabilitation are proposed and implemented by cities in accordance with their Smart City Proposals (SCPs).

The cities of Faridabad and Karnal have been selected for development as Smart Cities in Haryana. These Smart Cities have reported 2 slum re-development/retrofit projects at an estimated cost of ₹ 25.34 crore. Details are given below: -
