(a)&(b) The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) had approved the proposal for investment approval for Phase-I of “Bharatmala Pariyojana” on 24.10.2017. Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I include development of about 24,800 km NH network such as Economic corridors, Inter-corridor & feeder roads, National Corridors Efficiency Improvements, Border and International Connectivity roads, Coastal and Port Connectivity roads, Expressways as well as 10,000 km of roads under balance NHDP. Till now, projects comprising length of 22,302 kms with cost of Rs. 6,88,898 cr. have been awarded under Bharatmala Pariyojana and 9,548 kms project length has been completed.

(c) The status of works under Bharatmala Pariyojana in the State of Karnataka, Maharashtra and Jharkhand is as below:
