- (a) As per information available with University Grants Commission (UGC) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), 141 Universities (Central, State, Deemed to be Universities) and 1360 Technical Institutions have been opened/increased in the country during the last three years. Out of these, 10 universities and 30 technical institutions are in West Bengal. The district-wise details of these universities and institutions in the State of West Bengal are given at Annexure.
- (b) The number of students appeared in Class X and Class XII in Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE) Board examinations since 2017 are given below:
