(a): Yes, Sir. Airports Authority of India has entered into an agreement with Bharat Electronics Limited on 24th March, 2022 for the collaborative development of an indigenous Air Traffic Management (ATM) Automation System and Airport Surface Movement & Guidance Control System.

(b): The above effort is in line with making India self-reliant while modernising and expanding the ATM Automation Systems infrastructure within India. This initiative is expected to reduce foreign dependence of India for such systems, develop technical capabilities within India and save foreign reserves.
