NAI MANZIL SCHEME

1991. DR. G. RANJITH REDDY:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Nai Manzil helped school dropouts, particularly belonging to Muslims, in Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy, Sanga Reddy and Vikarabad districts of Telangana during the last three years and the current year, year and district-wise;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any skills are also imparted to above students under the said scheme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of budget allocated, sanctioned, released and spent on the above scheme in the said districts of Telangana during the said period, year and district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SMT SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) to (d) Yes Sir; Nai Manzil scheme has helped 5945 school drop outs in the State of Telangana. Training under the skills component of this scheme is for minimum 3 months and includes training in soft skills, basic IT and English, with focus on skill courses aligned at NSQF level 3 or above, with the objective of improving employability of the beneficiaries. Out of the above beneficiaries, 5607 have been trained and certified in job roles viz. Fitter Mechanical Assembly, Retail Trainee Associate, Assistant Electrician, Solar Panel Installation Technician & Self Employed Tailor.
- (e) Rs. 33.59 crores was sanctioned to the PIAs in the state of Telangana out of which Rs. 20.64 crores have been released so far since inception. Allocations under Nai Manzil scheme has not been done district wise but given at State level.
