#### HRIDAY SCHEME

#### NO. 2024. SHRI ANUMULA REVANTH REDDY:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of work done under National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) for Padmakshi temple, Warangal city since the inclusion of the city under HRIDAY scheme;
- (b) the budgetary allocation of funds and the funds utilised under the said scheme during the last three years and the current year, year and scheme-wise; and
- (c) the details of list of projects under HRIDAY scheme and work done under the said scheme since 2017, year-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) As per the information received from Kakatiya Urban Development Authority, Warangal, the work related to construction of toilet blocks, footpath pavers, landscaping and vehicular parking at Padmakshi Temple, Warangal city was carried out with an expenditure of approximately ₹ 0.70 crore under HRIDAY Scheme.

(b) HRIDAY, a central sector scheme of the Government of India, was launched on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2015. It was implemented in 12 cities of Ajmer (Rajasthan), Amaravati (Andhra Pradesh), Amritsar (Punjab), Badami (Karnataka), Dwarka (Gujarat), Gaya (Bihar), Kancheepuram and Velankanni (Tamil Nadu), Mathura and Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), Puri (Odisha), and Warangal (Telangana). The mission has ended on 31<sup>st</sup>March, 2019 and no new projects/cities were taken up after 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2019.

No funds have been allocated or released to any city in last three financial years i.e. 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, and current Financial Year 2022-23. As per Utilization certificates received from the cities till date, an amount of ₹322.74 crore has been utilized for the projects under HRIDAY scheme.

(c) On the basis of information received from the implementing agencies, the detailed list of the projects completed under HRIDAY scheme since 2017 is placed at Annexure.
