**SETTING UP OF SKILL HUB**

**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether it is true that the Government is planning to set-up Skill Hub across the country; if so, the details thereof, State-wise
- (b) the details of the funds allocated for development of the said Skill Hubs;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to establish any new Skill Hubs in Andhra Pradesh;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) Ministry of Skill development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) along with Ministry of Education has launched the Skill Hubs Initiative (SHI) as a pilot on 01.01.2022 under central component of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 3.0 (PMKVY 3.0). SHI is the integration and mainstreaming of vocational education with general education as has been envisaged under the National Education Policy, 2020 (NEP, 2020). Skill Hubs are nodal skill centres identified to provide skill development and vocational training opportunities to drop-outs and out of education candidates. The State wise details of SHI established are available at **ANNEXURE**.

(b) The total estimated outlay for the pilot SHI to train and certify candidates is Rs. 700 Crore. The last date of enrollment of candidates under the SHI-PMKVY 3.0 was 31.03.2022.

(c) & (d) SHI as a pilot project was launched across the country including Andhra Pradesh. There are 48 Skill Hubs in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
